The Sulcata Tortoises

Fun Facts:

- Sulcata Tortoises reach between two to three feet long.
- When full grown, Sulcatas weigh between 100 to 200 pounds!
- Sulcatas are herbivores (Plant eaters).
- Sulcata tortoises lay eggs in a burrow that they dig with their back legs.
- Sulcatas will lay between 15 to 30 eggs at a time.
- They live between 50-150 years in the wild.
