The Chinchillas

Fun Facts:

- Chinchillas are rodents that are related to guinea pigs and porcupines.
- They have bushy tails, four legs and round ears.
- Chinchillas are native to the Andes Mountains in northern Chile.
- Chinchillas like cold weather and cannot survive if the temperature is over 80 degrees.
- In the wild, chinchillas live in underground tunnels or in-between rocks.
- Baby chinchillas are kits and are born in litters of one to six babies.
- Chinchillas are omnivores, eating both plants and meats such as insects, bird's eggs, grass and seeds.
- They live between 8-20 years in the wild.

- Take a picture of your story and upload it to the comments section of the video on Facebook with your parents' permission.

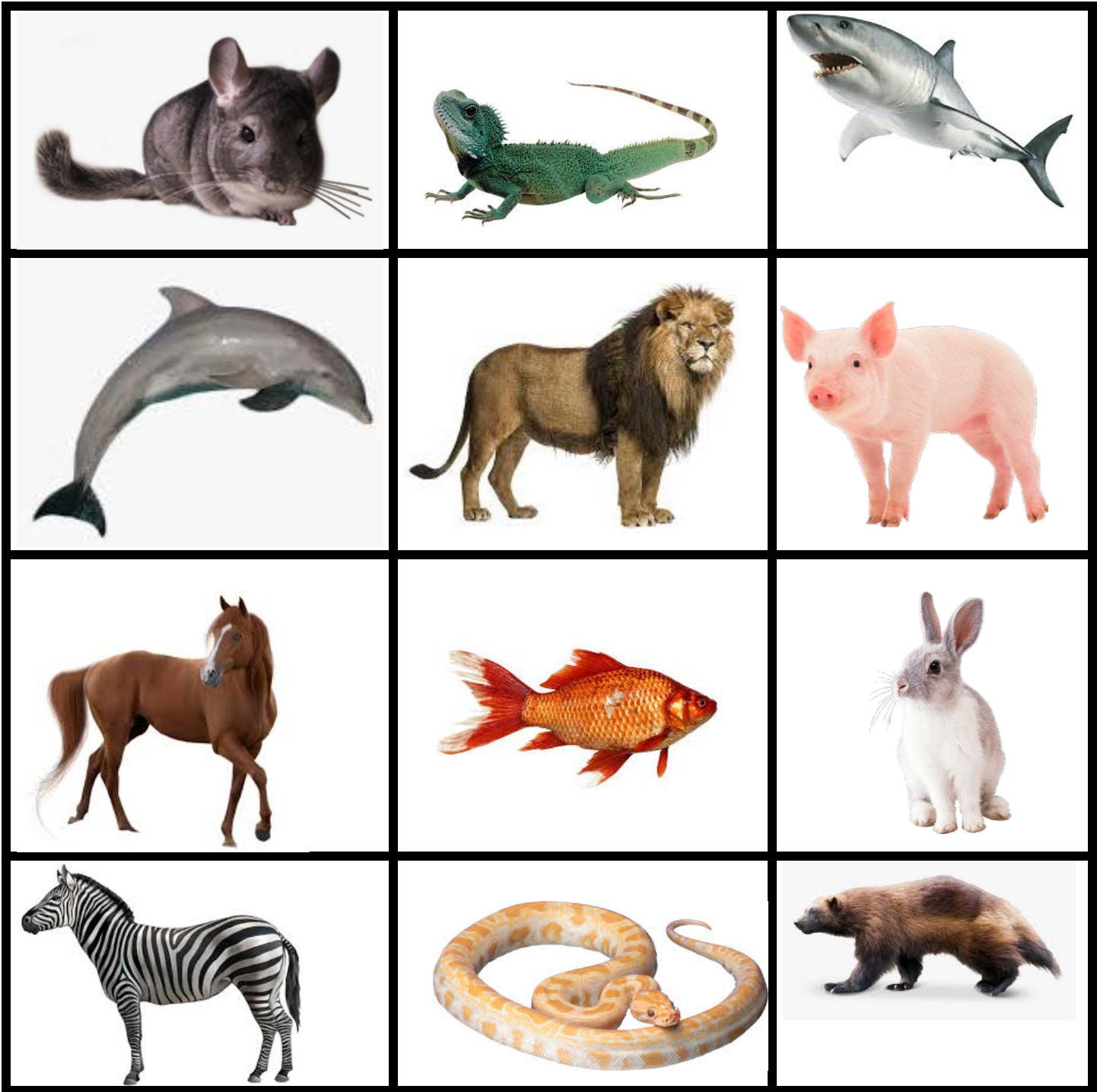
Body Covering Sort:
