- Lizards are reptiles.

Activities:

- Find a string and have an adult cut it to the length of your arm. This is about the length of a bearded dragon!
- Use the string to measure various objects to see if they are longer or shorter than the string.
- Find 3 things that are shorter and 3 that are longer.
