The Sulcata Tortoises

Fact Review:

- Sulcata Tortoises reach between 2 to 3 feet in length.
- Adult Sulcatas weigh between 100 to 200 pounds!
- Sulcatas are herbivores (Plant eaters).
- Sulcata's use their shell for shelter.
- Sulcata tortoises lay eggs in a burrow that they dig with their back legs.
- Sulcatas will lay between 15 to 30 eggs at a time.
- They live between 50-150 years in the wild.
